Financials



Our 2020 Form 990 provides details of all our income, expenses, and administrative costs. We are very happy to see MH4H had an administrative cost percentage of 14.26%. What that means: for every \$1.00 given to Many Hands for Haiti, \$.85 of that dollar goes toward programs. The benchmark for administrative costs for nonprofits according to Charity Navigator is 33%.

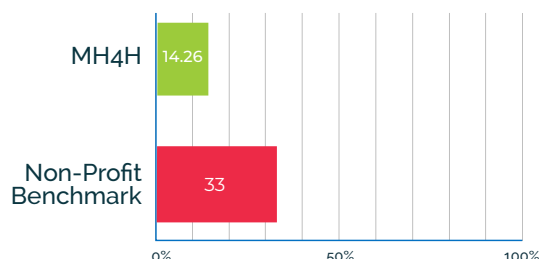

74 goats born to families that received a pregnant goat

600 goat checks administered by vets and vet techs

Served an estimated 225,000 plates of food to pregnant women, young children, and families

Performed over 350 wellness health checks on our students

Distributed 67 tons of food to local area schools

6 homes rebuilt for families

20 cement floors installed in homes

60 hand-washing stations built
